
Protecting those who need it as we reopen.



Lockport Shield is a group of local volunteers dedicated to helping citizens most vulnerable to COVID-19. As we emerge from the Governor's shelter-in mandate, those over 60 years of age, or with pre-existing medical conditions who choose to stay isolated in the reopening phase are encouraged to ask Shield Volunteers for help.

The City of Lockport along with Lockport Love, a trusted 501(c)(3), are organizing volunteers who are ready to assist those who ask. Volunteers can do grocery runs, cut grass, and run simple errands, so our community's "at risk" population can stay protected. Local fitness trainers are providing online tips and videos to stay healthy.
